Sub: - Implementation of Supreme Court order annulling MACP anomalies to be extended to the entire Accounts Department of Indian Railways – reg.

Ref: - My earlier letter dated 16/12/2015.

Kindly refer to my earlier letter cited above regarding the implementation of Supreme Court order SLP(C) no. 1325 - 1330/2015 dated 11/08/2015.

As the aggrieved litigants of S. Rly.numbering 73, have been awarded Rs. 5400 GP, with arrears, the rest of the staff who have been placed in the similar position are yet to receive the pay parity. I like to reiterate as per the establishment rules in case of any order passed by the courts regarding establishment matters, it should be taken as standing principle to settle similar issues. As it is already a settled matter in the court of law and there is no avenue for the administration for any further trial in the court ,it may therefore be considered favorably.

Hence the staff who have not gone to court and who are similarly placed may be given pay parity in line with those who have gone to court.

I once again seek your good office to render justice at the earliest in this matter.
