Sub: - Request - Fixation of pay - Opportunity to exercise OPTION under the provision to Rule 5 in writing in the Form appended to the Second Schedule in the Cases of Promotion taking place in the **pre-revised pay structure between 1.1.2006 and the date of Notification of RS(RP)Rules, 2008** and the subsequent merger of the pre-revised Pay scales of the Promotional and the Feeder posts in a common Grade -

With due respect, it is for your kind information that Railway Board has considered the Cases of Promotion taking place in the pre-revised pay structure between 1.1.2006 and the date of Notification of RS(RP)Rules 2008, and the subsequent merger of the pre-revised pay scales of the Promotional and the

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Feeder posts in a common Grade - Fixation of Pay vide Railway Board letter referred above (RBE No.33/2016) and the Re-fixation is allowed by the Administration, but the opportunity to exercise the Option under the provision to Rule 5 in the Form appended to the Second Schedule, is not provided; resulting the loss in Basic Pay not only in the fixation of 6th CPC but also further in the fixation of 7th CPC right from the date of promotion which have taken place between 1.1.2006 and the date of notification of RS(RP)Rules, 2008. Copy of a Chart of such Loss in Basic Pay of a Railway employee who promoted from SO A/Cs to SSO A/Cs in 5th CPC on 30.11.2006, is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and reference please, in which the Loss of Basic Pay at this time is Rs.2300/- per month.

It is notable that while issuing the above referred orders by Railway Board, Kindly refer previous Railway Board orders along-with a copy of Office Memorandum No. F-2-1/2015-E.III(A) Dated 16.10.2015 issued by Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) for necessary action.

As per this Office Memorandum - Para 5, it is mentioned that these orders were issued to protect the status of a Govt. Servant as on 29.08.2008 and as per Para 6(iii) the concerned employee who had opted to come over to the revised pay structure from a date prior to the date of notification of CCS(RP)Rules 2008, while re-fixing the Pay in these cases, Railway Administration did not provide the opportunity to exercise the right of Option.

Hence, you are hereby requested to look into this matter personally and arrange to provide the opportunity to exercise the Option as per Rules so that the staff who suffered the loss in Basic Pay during this re-fixation may be avoided.
