Sub: Implementation of improved V CPC pay scale arrears w.e.f 01.01.1996
 Instead of 19.02.2003-reg

Your kind attention is drawn to the fact that 5th CPC Pay Scales were granted to the Railway Accounts employees notionally w.e.f 19.02.2003 and arrears on this account has not been paid from 01.01.1996. It is brought to your kind notice that the litigation filed on this matter has attained finality, consequent to the issuance of Judgement dated 18.08.2021 of Hon'ble Supreme court of India, in the review petition filed by UOI vide Diary No.7547/2021, duly affirming the judgement passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 18.12.2019 in WP(C)1523/2016. However, no arrears have been paid to the beneficiaries till date.

In this connection, Finance Ministry has been addressed by Railway Board and It is learnt that Finance Ministry has also sought legal opinion from Board on implementation of the Court judgments and further decisions depends on the reply thereon, in this matter.

As already more than two decades are over, further delay in implementing the orders of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi dated 18.12.2019 may lead to resentment among the Railway Accounts employees.

Hence, kind appeal is made for intervening into the matter and necessary clearance may be given to Railway Board for implementing the arrears benefit of V CPC due to the Railway Accounts staff without further loss of time and put an end to the two decades long wait and render justice.
