regarding MACP anomaly in Accts Dept.

Ref: Our Letter dated 14.1.12, 28.1.15, 21.3.15 & 7.8.15

This Association has fervently represented to Board and your goodself regarding the grave anomalies resulted in the implementation of MACP, rendering even the Accts. Assts. to draw more pay than the Sr. Supervisors. This has brought great discontentment among the Supervisory staff of the Accts Dept throughout Indian Railways.

A few of the Accounts staff from S.Rly have preferred to go to court to settle the claim and had obtained a favorable judgment in the Supreme Court as per the above order which has annulled the disparity in the pay drawn by the Sr. Supervisors in the Accts Department. Hence our stand has been vindicated.

This Assn. requests the administration to implement the judgment in true spirit to all the staff of Accounts cadre including those similarly placed but not approached the Hon'ble Court.

Our Assn has always believed in Negotiation and bestowed faith in administration to render justice and hence large section of our staff did not approach the Court for remedy.

As the Administration is the custodian of the interest of the employee, Justice should be rendered in equivantly to all the staff who have been affected, irrespective of whether they have gone to the Court or not.

Any discrimination in the implementation between the miniscule staff who have preferred litigation to that of large section of those who have not preferred litigation, will only lead to acrimony and discontentment and will further open the Pandora Box for more litigations from the discontented staff, which in turn will burden the administration.

Hence we once again request speedy implementation of Hon'ble Supreme Court order in true spirit to render justice to all the affected staff of the Accts cadre to annul the MACP anomaly.
